Live action broadcasted from Championship race-courses.

To accompany the sharing of the sailing action, it is also a key pillar of IN15CA activity to provide effective communication and administration along with a hub of reference and knowledge via the IN15CA Web-site.

Currently, class funds are primarily raised through direct support from Nacra Sailing, Membership fees and event revenue.

To help us all move forwards the 2020 IN15CA Membership fee structure is as follows:

Individual membership: 50 Euros

Memberships run annually from January to December each year, payable either direct to IN15CA or via your National Nacra 15 Class Association. An IN15CA On-line payment portal will be available via the Class Web-site January 2020 onwards. This updated link will be shared as soon as the new system is available.

Class Equipment fees:

Complete New Boat Fee (Inc World Sailing Plaque Fee and 1 year's Helm and Crew membership)	140 Euros
Mainsail Fee	25 Euros
Gennaker Fee	25 Euros
Jib Fee	15 Euros
