The five 2024 Nacra 15 European Super Series events are:

30 March – 5 April	RYA Youth National Championships, UK Weymouth
5 - 7 July	Dunkerque, France
8 – 11 August	Open Hungarian Championships (Lake Balaton)
14 – 15 September	Open Belgian Youth Championships, Knokke, Belgium
11 – 13 October	Open Swiss National Championships

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY AND EVENTS

- 1.1 The five individual events are organized by the organizing authority of the sailing venue/event in conjunction with the International Nacra 15 Class Association.
Links to the individual events can be found on the IN15CA website.

2. RULES

- 2.1 The individual events will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and their Notice of Race & Sailing Instructions.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The individual events are open to Nacra 15 sailors and requirements are defined in the individual notice of race of each event. Registration to each event is possible per event via the event websites.
- 3.2 To count in the SuperSeries sailors must be a fully 2024 member of the International Nacra 15 Class Association before the individual event they are participating. IN15CA Membership registration is possible via our website <http://www.nacra15class.com/membership/>

4. SAFETY

- 4.1 All competitors have to comply the safety rules in the class rules. Further requirements may be defined in the individual notice of race of each event.

5. CLASS RULES & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 5.1 The Nacra 15 Class Rules will apply during all events of the Nacra 15 SuperSeries.
Measurement, full adherence to class rules **shall** be followed, spot checks **may** take place.

6. ADVERTISING, FEES, SCHEDULE, EQUIPMENT INSPECTION, SAILING INSTRUCTIONS, COURSES, PENALTY SYSTEM, SUPPORT BOATS, BERTHING, RADIO COMMUNICATION, INSURANCE ETC.

6.1 Each individual event will produce an individual Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions including all necessary information.

7. SCORING SUPERSERIES OVERALL RANKING

7.1 A team's best **three** regattas' results count for the overall ranking. The winner will be the team with the lowest total score in the circuit (based on low point scoring per event).

7.2 Everyone is ranked, even if they have only raced 1 or 2 regattas.

7.3 Points received for the non-attended events will be the highest points + 1 from the largest event.

7.4 If there is a tie, the results of the last event in which both teams participated will be used to define the winner.

7.4.2 If there is still a tie, the team that participated in the most events will be the winner.

7.5 Change of helm or crew will result in a separate score for each combination.

8. PRIZES

8.1 The first three teams in the overall result of the SuperSeries in the following categories will be awarded medals by the International Nacra 15 Class Association:

1,2,3 Overall Open

1,2,3 Overall < 19 years

1,2,3 Overall < 17 years

Additional prizes may be awarded

The overall winners will be crowned: the 2024 Nacra 15 European SuperSeries Champions.

8.2 Results of the categories <19 and <17 are calculated by extraction without recalculation.

8.3 The overall prizegiving of the European SuperSeries 2024 will be during the final day of the SuperSeries 2024 in Swiss, Geneva (13 October).

9. CAMERAS AND/OR TRACKING SYSTEMS

9.1 Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment as specified and provided by the Organizing Authority and/or International Nacra 15 Class Association.

10. [DP] MEDIA RIGHTS

10.1 By participating in the SuperSeries or in any individual event competitors automatically grant IN15CA the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any still or motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

11. USE OF DATA

11.1 By participating in the SuperSeries or in any individual event competitors automatically grant IN15CA and the local organizers to use data processed to register individuals as entrants, to manage race entries, to communicate race participation, to collect registration fees and to carry out other common activities relating to the organisation of the race. Also processes and publish on-line the race results, entry lists and protest information for organizational purposes .

12. LIABILITY AND EXCLUSION

Competitors and support teams participate in the Super Series entirely at their own risk and they are reminded of the provisions of RRS 4, Decision to Race. Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore involves an element of risk.
