

Nacra 17 the Ultimate Racing Machine

In May 2012, World Sailing selected the Nacra 17 as the new equipment for the mixed multihull event at Rio de Janeiro in 2016. Which made the Nacra 17 event, the first-ever mixed-gender sailing sport discipline at the Olympic Games.

First fully foiling class in Olympic Games

In 2015, the Class and World Sailing agreed to evolve the boat to become a fully foiling Multihull, to be sailed at the 2020 Olympic Games in Japan. The class and Nacra Sailing started an extended testing program to develop a fully foiling multihull, the Nacra 17. In 2016 the Class and World Sailing accepted the changes, followed by the Class's first foiling event in Spring 2017.

Olympic Games mixed Multihull Class

The Nacra 17 is the Multihull equipment that is used in the "Olympic mixed multihull class" running up to the Olympic Games in Paris 2024. Every year several World Sailing Cups, World Championships, and other continental championships go down where the elite multihull sailors of the world race one another.

Foiling is the future

In 2021 the Nacra 17 showcased some impressive sailing by the best sailing athletes at the 2020 Olympics in Japan. Making it the first foiling sail equipment ever used at the Olympic Games. Foiling is now part of high-performance sailing, together with Foiling Kiteboard and windsurf Olympic classes.

Nacra 17 Class Association
